- 3) Suggestion regarding possibly changing the rule regarding stallions competing in the USA and the requirement to stand in Canada for 3 months during the breeding season to be eligible to stand in the super stakes auction.
- 4) Discussion was held regarding whether or not it is acceptable to change start times at our CBHI event.
- 5) There was a suggestion that a stallion owner should be allowed to place their farm picks on offspring sired by any of their stallions in the CBHI and not just the offspring of their stallion who stood in the super stakes auction.
